## WHAT IS INDIRECT COVE LIGHTING?

Indirect cove lighting is light projected up into the dome from a source that is hidden from view. A separate trim ring (See diagram below) is permanently attached at the factory. Rope lighting is then placed behind the inside lip. As is evident from the pictures this creates a candle glow ambiance unique to this style of dome.

Normally the control for the rope lighting is independent of the chandler and hooked to a rheostat. The power for the rope lighting goes through a hole in the dome itself. The hole like the rope lighting is behind the lip of the cove and can not be seen. The wiring runs up into the attic over to a light switch.

We can supply you with the rope lighting or your electrician will know where to buy it locally. These cove trim rings are available on all sizes of our domes.

In addition to the above, decorative trim can be added to the flat cove surface adding even more elegance to the room.
